Cancer-Causing Materials Found in School Turf

Substances that can cause cancer have been found in artificial turf at schools. According to an environmental group in Gyeonggi Province, Monday, a large amount of poisonous metals and other harmful materials were found in man-made lawns in the playgrounds of three schools inspected at the beginning of this month.

The environmental group said one of the three schools had 290mg of lead in its artificial lawn, three times more than the allowed figure of 90mg, and other two schools had 46.7mg and 810mg of polyaromatic hydrocarbon, which includes Beazopyrene,

Heavy metals such as lead can cause health problems when swallowed or inhaled. At very high levels they can cause seizures, comas and even death. Beazopyrene more than 10mg of which is dangerous — is a product of incomplete combustion that
